	Number of participants in the activity that quantitatively demonstrated understanding of protective factors	<p>Through pre- and post- test or a substantive test of knowledge, a percentage of the participants in each activity that demonstrated a change in knowledge, skills, or behaviors at the conclusion of the prevention activity. If activity is a single incident activity, measurement of knowledge, skills, or behaviors pre-activity and post-activity. If an activity is a multiple incident activity, measurement of knowledge, skills, or behaviors should occur at the beginning of the activity and at the end of the activity, or after a pre-determined session. Pre- and post- tests will be provided by OVS.</p> <p>Number of participants who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Did not submit an evaluation Demonstrated a positive change in knowledge, skills, or behaviors 	<p>Demonstration that grantee is administering pre- and post- tests in all activities listed in the first measure and that the analysis provided to OVS is accurate.</p> <p>Information needed from grantee:</p> <p>Proposed tests (pre- / post- or substantive test of knowledge) that will be used to test change in behavior, skill, or knowledge. **OVSJG must approve test before use**</p>

	Number of participants in the activity that qualitatively demonstrated understanding of protective factors	<p>Through documented observation or written anecdotes at the conclusion of the activity, participants are demonstrating ability to use new behaviors. Activity leader should either ask participants to describe in writing or through behavior an understanding of the content of the training.</p> <p>Describe qualitative observations or written anecdotes of a participant's willingness and ability to use new behaviors</p> <p>(Grantee should include at least one positive qualitative observation and one negative observation)</p>	<p>Demonstration that grantee is conducting observational assessments or collecting written anecdotes at the conclusion of each activity listed in the first measure and that the analysis provided by OVS is supported by the observational assessments (documented by the grantee staff at the conclusion of the event) or the written anecdotes provided by the event participants</p>
