# Preface

- The numbers contained in this presentation represent students who are enrolled in the District and part of the UPSFF-eligible<sup>+</sup> population.

<sup>+</sup>UPSFF-eligible students are attending the LEA itself and not at non-public placements.

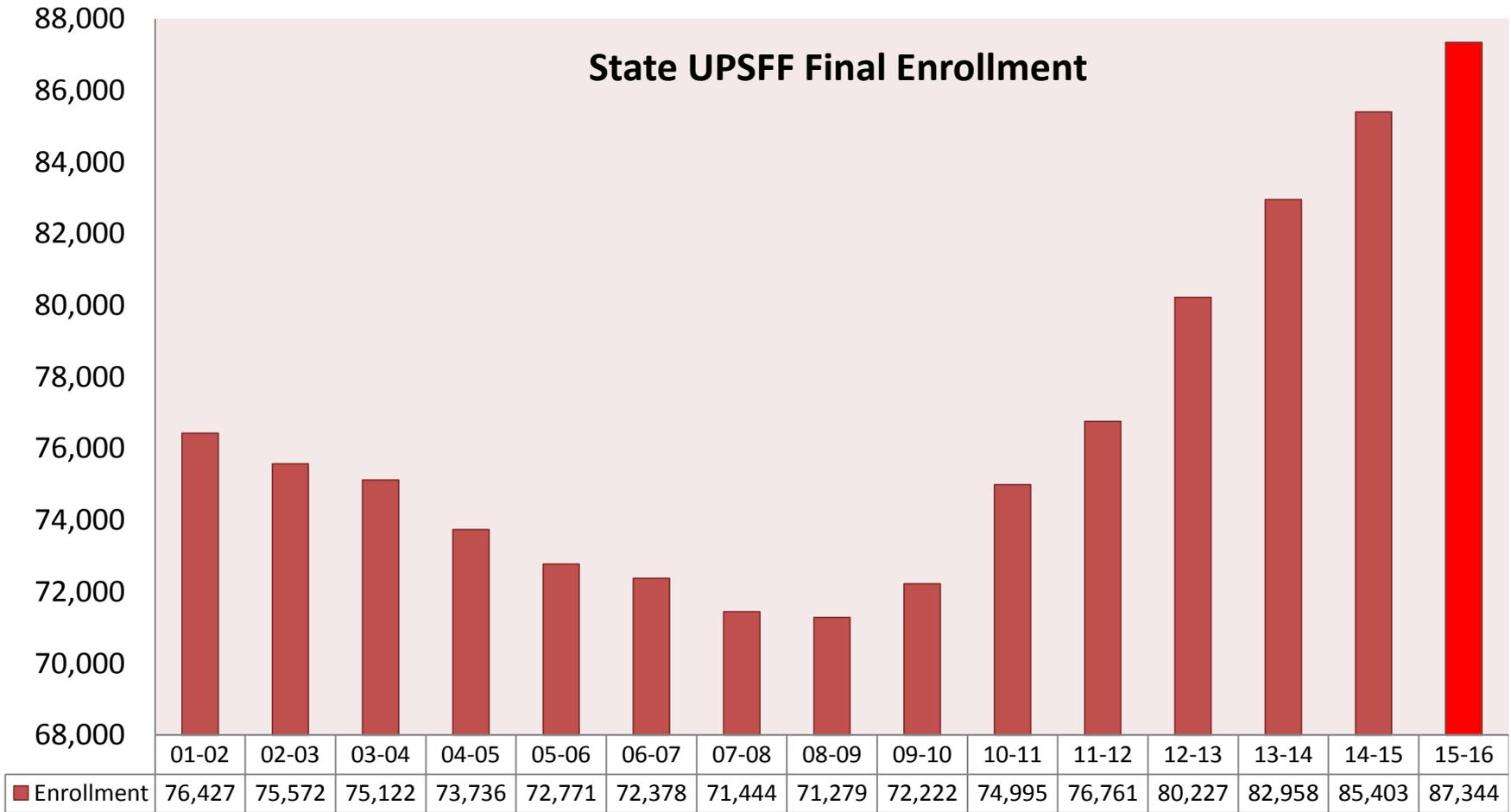

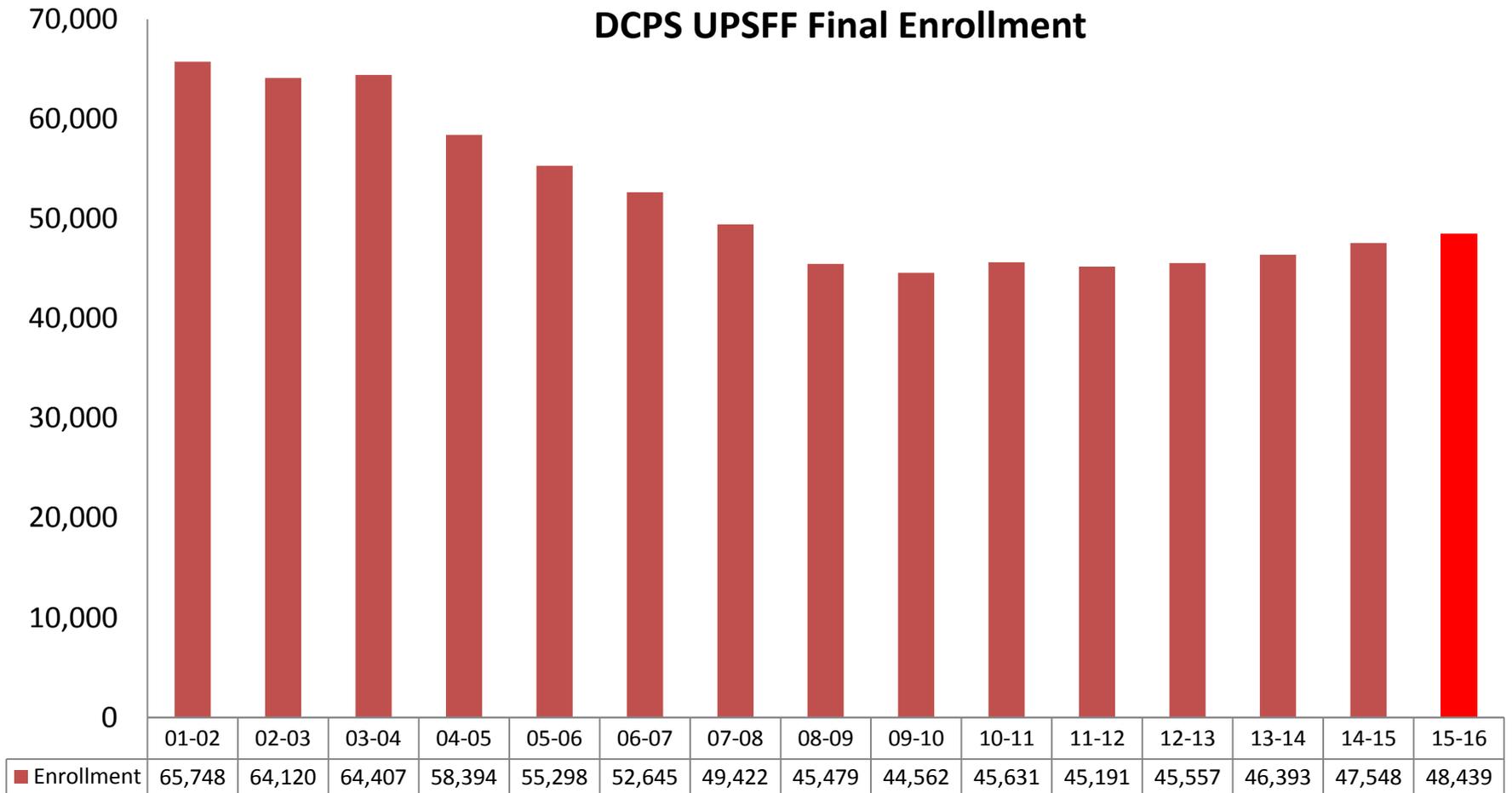

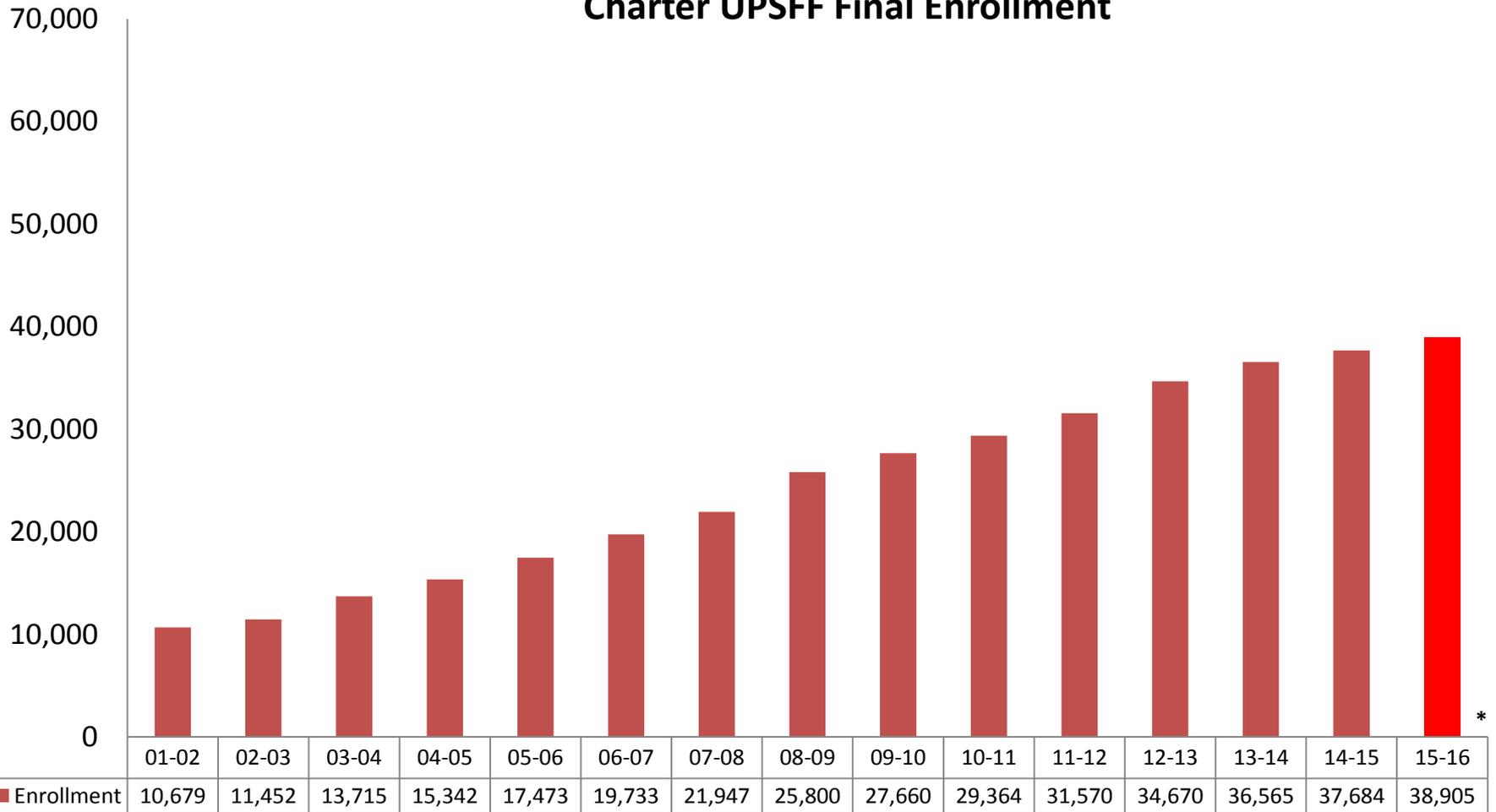
