



## FY 2017 Show Up, Stand Out Consolidated Community Based Organization (CBO) & Youth Service Provider (YSP) RFA #2017-05

### Frequently Asked Questions:

**1. Is a logic model required?**

Yes, this goes along with the project work plan.

**2. If a school is not listed in the RFA that we are looking to partner with, can we recruit and include them in our application?**

Yes, potential partnering school can be added to the application, however final decision on school partners will be made by OVSJG when truancy rates for schools are provided.

**3. On page 6 of the RFA; it mentions the "Show Up, Stand Out Program Advisory Committee". Please describe.**

This is the "new" name for the bi-monthly program meetings that were conducted in prior years.

**4. Can a lead CBO use an existing YSP provider; as well as solicit the services of another youth service provider outside of the SUSO network? Essentially; if a CBO is working with a youth service provider that is not currently under the SUSO program; can we include them in FY 17 programming?**

Yes, you can include other YSP's not currently working with SUSO. However, OVSJG still has to approve the YSP and has the right to decline the partnership. Preference will be given to current YSP's.

**5. Can an organization that was an YSP last year now bid as a CBO under the new consolidated RFA?**

Yes, but will have to have the capacity to house both family and youth engagement.

**6. What is the grant award period and project commencement date?**

The award period is from 10/1/2016 – 9/30/2017. Projects are required to begin on 10/1/2016.

**7. Can the lead organization if capable of and has experience providing both the family and the youth model elect not to subcontract to a youth service provider?**

Yes, the lead agency can do both models in house however it is mandatory that two different types of group models are provided to students to participate in. (i.e. active activity and mentoring activity)



**8. Can case management services be contracted to an organization that utilizes OJJDP best practice models?**

Yes, case management services can be contracted out to another organization. However, OVSJG will give preference to organizations that can house case management without contracting with another organization.

**9. Are letters of commitment from current partnering schools required or just new schools that we are looking to expand to?**

Yes, letters of commitment are required from all schools you are partnering with, new and current.

**10. Are there any limitations on the use of Flex Funds to help support families?**

Yes, there are limitations but these are accessed on a case by case basis. The CBO will have to notify OVSJG if there are out of the ordinary circumstances in the use of flex funds for approval. Flex funds are usually used for attendance parities, school uniforms, etc.
