

Medical and Forensic Services:

For the purposes of the OVSJG PMI, medical services are services that engage professional care provided by a clinician with appropriate licensure that is intended to identify and treat injury and physical needs of a crime victim. Forensic services are services that seek to collect evidence for use in a legal proceeding or to review evidence for future use.
