Consolidated Justice Grants  
Request for Applications**

The Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants (OVSJG) announces the availability of justice grants funding for FY 2027.

**Purpose/Description:**

The Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants announce the availability of grant funds under the Fiscal Year 2027 consolidated funds RFA to propose strategies designed to implement criminal justice, reentry, and juvenile justice programs. OVSJG seeks to fund programs that improve public safety; enhance the administration of justice; and create systems of care for youth, victims of crime, and justice-involved individuals.

**Funding in this RFA includes:**

Local, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) BYRNE Justice, The Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP).

**\*\* District agencies only:** The Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT) and Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant Program funds.

**Eligible Organizations/Entities:** Any public or private, community-based non-profit agency, organization, or institution located in the District of Columbia is eligible to apply, including District government agencies. For-profit organizations are eligible but may not include profit in their grant application. For-profit organizations may also participate as subcontractors to eligible agencies.

**Length of Award:** The grant award is for Fiscal Year 2027. The funding period is October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2027

**RFA Release:** The Request for Applications (RFA) will be available electronically beginning Monday, May 18, 2026 at [OVSJG Current Opportunities](#) and the District's Grant Clearing House website at [Community Grant Program](#).
