There was one arrest made in a homicide case in which video footage was extracted from a security camera owned by a program participant. MPD detectives may have viewed footage that was obtained directly from the program participants without that information being specifically tracked.

**8. An analysis of the Program's implementation and plans for future expansion, if any.**

The program continues to be successful with no plans for future expansion.

OVSJG continues to do community outreach for the program. OVSJG participated in neighborhood safety walk, an east of the river resource fair, the Ward 4 economic summit, the ANC 1A meeting and made a presentation at the DC365 civic association.

\*As of August 1, 2016 all PSAs are eligible to apply for rebates. Prior to August 1, 2016 rebate applications from PSAs 101, 102, 201, 203, 204, 205, 206,301, 304, 306, 401, 408, 601, 605, and 606 were ineligible. Until September 1, 2017, voucher applications from PSAs 101, 102, 201, 203, 204, 205, 206,301, 304, 306, 401, 408, 601, 605, 606 and 607 are ineligible.

In January 2019, MPD realigned PSA boundaries. The data in this report reflects the PSA at the time of application.
